



Alongside school or college you can study other subjects remotely through the Catholic College Wales.

What does it offer?

A wider curriculum offer with access to subjects which may not be available in your home sixth form.

The opportunity to work in a different way accessing online lessons in twilight sessions.

The opportunity to study with other students in Catholic sixth forms across Wales.

A commitment to foster and develop ability in, and understanding of, the Welsh language and the culture of Wales.

In 2021-22 the providers of post-16 Catholic education in Wales made a commitment to work in partnership to develop an online provision for its learners.

This offer for 2022-23 will complete the final phase of a two-year pilot with the aim of establishing a National Catholic College. The National Catholic College will be entirely online working alongside school sixth forms and St David's College and will be ready for admissions in 2023-24.



To enable students to have the best experience in school accessing the remote courses we will be installing a new ICT suite for our sixth form students.

The beauty of the Catholic College Wales is that it allows flexibility, outside usual school hours, but opens up so many more opportunities for our students. The College strengthens provision for post-16 learners by offering breadth of choice.
